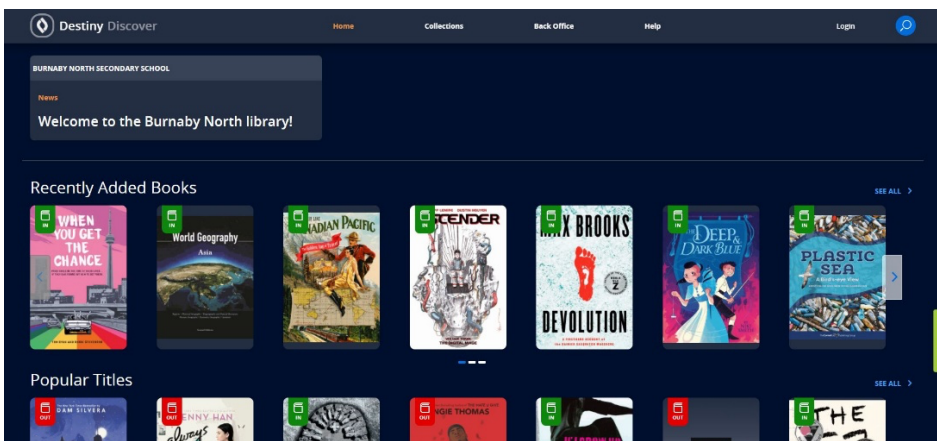

How do I use the Destiny catalogue?

The catalogue works best on the school computers if you use Google Chrome.

Go to the Burnaby North home page (<http://north.burnabyschools.ca>), hover over the **'Library'** tab in the upper right, and then click on **'Catalogue'**.

Click the 'Login' icon at the top right, then click the blue 'SD 41 Burnaby SAML SSO' bar. If it doesn't automatically log you in, use your Office 365 login (username: your school email address, password: your email password). Once you're logged in you can do things like put books on hold, search the databases, view your checkouts, etc.

Try a search using Destiny Discover

Note: unless you choose a specific type of search using the dropdown menu beside the search bar, Destiny will automatically do a Keyword search.

Do a **Title** search first (use the dropdown menu to choose **'Title'** under **'search type'**, then click **'Search'**):

Search for the following title: ***Astronomy and Space***, click on the first book, then click **'View More Details'**

Now do a keyword search (make sure you switch from 'title' to 'keyword') for ***Astronomy and Space***



Try searching for websites using Destiny Discover

Start a new search. Type 'science fair' into the search bar and hit enter.

Once the results come up, click 'Websites' on the center results bar.

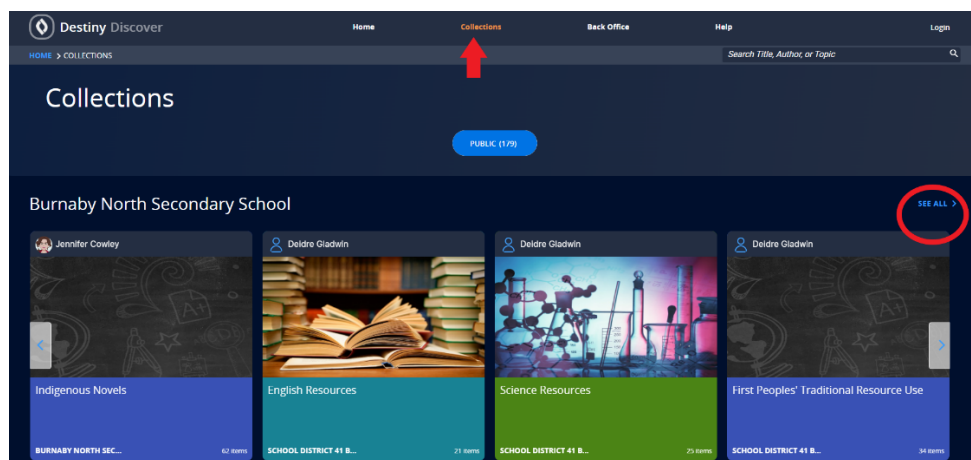
